Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for setting aside condition (IV) of the order dated 28.08.2018, Annexure P-2, vide which the petitioner has been asked to seek permission each time to travel abroad while granting bail in FIR No.243, dated 07.05.2018, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC (Sections 420, 34 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner candidly submits that he has approached this Court by way of present petition as on earlier occasions whenever he was required to go abroad, he filed an application for grant of permission to go abroad, however, exorbitant time was being taken in deciding the same. He submits that as the avocation of the petitioner is such that frequently he has to go abroad and

submits that if an appropriate direction is given to the concerned Court for deciding such application expeditiously, he would be satisfied.

Heard.

After hearing the parties, this Court finds it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the concerned Court that if in future petitioner files an application for seeking permission to go abroad in accordance with Condition No.438(2)(iii) Cr.P.C., the same be decided expeditiously and preferably within seven days from the date of its filing.

Disposed of accordingly.
