This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the petition dated 10.12.2021 (Annexure P-11) submitted by the petitioner under Section 117 (2) of Border Security Force Act, 1968 against the order of punishment dated 15.9.2021 (Annexure P-7), as informed to the petitioner through letter dated 15.9.2021 (Annexure P-9), as expeditiously as possible.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Dhiraj Jain, Senior Counsel for UOI, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and, on instructions, submits that none of the officers is against the petitioner as such. The statutory petition filed by

the petitioner is, otherwise also, likely to be decided within a period of three months.

In view of the above statement, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be so grateful to the respondent authorities if they take a decision on the petition and consider his case sympathetically.
