This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners at the instance of respondents No. 4 to 7, as the petitioners want to marry each other and presently want to live together against the wishes of the private respondents.

Learned State counsel on the instructions from HC Paramjit Singh submits that the petitioners are now not living together and they do not have any threat to their life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instruction from his clients.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner are now living separately and they do not have any threat to their life and liberty, no further order is called for in the present petitioner.
