Instant petition had been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.16 dated 27.11.2013 under Sections 447, 379, 380, 417, 201 and 511 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station NRI, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned Sr. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has apprised the Court that during the pendency of the present petition before this Court, the evidence of prosecution as well as defence has already been concluded and the case is now fixed for 19.07.2022 for final arguments.

In this view of the matter, it would only be appropriate that a final judgment be passed by the trial Court which is seized of the matter and the entire evidence by the respective parties have already been led.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, the petitioner would at liberty to raise all necessary pleas before the trial Court at the stage of final arguments.
