Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the case of the petitioner for grant of parole under Section 3 (1) (d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act 1962 has not been decided where he had applied for the grant of eight weeks' parole to meet his family members along with the Panchayatnama to the jail authorities. The said representation having not been decided till date, a prayer has been made that a writ of mandamus be issued for doing the needful and taking a decision thereon.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Monika Jalota, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In case the assertion made by the petitioner is found to be

correct and that the petitioner had submitted an application/request dated 13.09.2021 to the jail authorities for grant of eight weeks' parole to meet his family members and to look after the household affairs, the same, if already not decided, be decided within a period of three weeks from today. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

The present writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
