Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of necessary direction to the respondents to comply with the order dated 06.11.2018 (Annexure P-1), passed by learned Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Panipat and judgment dated 06.02.2019 (Annexure P-2), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat, vide which, respondent No.4/Tehsildar is appointed as a receiver under Sections 145/146 Cr.P.C. and directed to attach the disputed land measuring 4 kanal 17 marlas, situated at village Pathri, Tehsil Israna, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of this Court an order dated 06.11.2018 (P-1), the implementation of which is being sought, has been stayed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this

Court vide order dated 27.02.2019, passed in CRM-M-8595-2019 and the said case is stated to be pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file an appropriate petition/proceeding, in accordance with law, after the final decision of the said petition i.e. CRM-M-8595-2019.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
