AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

2. This petition under Section 482 filed aggrieved of order dated 9th December, 2021, whereby the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in case DDR No. 29, dated 13th October, 2020, a cross version under Sections 323, 452, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 in FIR No. 166, dated 12th October, 2020, under Sections 307, 323, 452, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within fifteen days from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.
