HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J.(Oral)

The present petition has been filed for the grant of interim bail to the petitioner so as to attend the marriage of her daughter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, whose daughter is getting married, is required to perform certain ceremonies in her marriage and, therefore, the petitioner be granted the concession of interim bail, as the petitioner, who was also granted interim bail on an earlier occasion, surrendered back without misusing the said concession.

Learned State counsel, by placing reliance upon the status report dated 29.3.2022 submits that the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is fixed for 03.4.2022.

Keeping in view the fact that the daughter of the petitioner is getting married and the requirement of mother is essential for conducting certain rituals coupled with the fact that the petitioner did not misuse the concession of interim bail earlier granted to her, the prayer of the petitioner for grant of interim bail from 31.3.2022 till 10.04.2022 is accepted as learned counsel for the petitioner has assured this Court that not only the petitioner will surrender back after availing interim bail but will also not misuse the same in any manner.

The petitioner is directed to surrender back to the jail authorities before 05:00 PM on 10.04.2022.

Petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail as stated hereinbefore subject to satisfaction of illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
