Present application has been filed for placing on record the judgment dated 18.12.2019 in CWP No.7239 of 2015 as Annexure P-8.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the same is allowed and Annexure P-8 is taken on record.

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In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that the concession of full pension after qualifying service of 25 years should be made applicable upon the employees, who retired after 01.01.2006 instead of 30.11.2011.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the

respondents.

As the judgment in *CWP No.7239 of 2015 titled as Labh Singh Dhaliwal and others versus State of Punjab*, was pronounced on 18.12.2019 i.e. after the case of the petitioner was rejected, the respondents needs to reconsider the prayer of the petitioners keeping in view the judgment in *Labh Singh Dhaliwal's case (supra)*.

Learned State counsel submits that though the judgment has not been attained finality as the same is pending consideration before the Division Bench in LPA No.691 of 2020 but still, keeping in view the position as it exist, appropriate consideration on the prayer of the petitioner will again be rendered in view of the judgment of this Court in *Labh Singh Dhaliwal's case (supra)* and appropriate order will be passed afresh within a period of three months of the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
