The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take appropriate action against respondent No.3 for attempting to thought free and fair investigation in the matter.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 26.02.2020. Learned counsel appearing for respondent-UT on instructions from Akhtar Hussain, PP-ISBT, Chandigarh submits that respondent No.3 was not associated with the investigation in the present case and the FIR No.212 dated 31.12.2020 under Sections 420, 448, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC was lodged pursuant to the direction of the Magistrate which was carried out by him, the investigation of which is near completion and thereafter, the final report shall be submitted in accordance with law.

Accordingly, no further order is required to be passed in the matter and the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
