VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR no.96 dated 01.07.2015 registered under Sections 177 and 420 IPC at Police Station Division no.2, District Ludhiana and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that since the parties are not appearing before the trial Court for recording their statements, thus, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue the petition i.e. CRM-M-30923-2016 which he has filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., on merits.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

It is made clear that in case the parties enter into a compromise and are ready to give their statements, it is open to the petitioners to file a fresh petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
