Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of FIR No.006 dated 06.01.2020 registered under Section 363 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short "IPC"), however, Sections 376(2)(n), 342, 34 IPC and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 have been added later on, at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise deed dated 04.03.2022 (Annexure P-4).

Status report by way of an affidavit of Assistant Superintendent of Police, SDPO/South West, Chandigarh has been filed, which is taken on record.

Upon instructions from SI Sapinder Singh, learned Additional

Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of U.T.Chandigarh submits that although in the first statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C, the prosecutrix had stated that she left her paternal home of her own, but in her subsequent statement, she has levelled allegation of sexual assault against the petitioner. Counsel submits that marriage between the parties has taken place thereafter.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
