Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0031 dated 09.02.2022 for offences punishable under Sections 61,1,14 of The Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.03.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Gurbakshish Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Derrabassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali and on instructions from ASI Onkar Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 14.03.2022 and is not required for custodial

interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 14.03.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
