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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 34 dated 15.2.2022 registered under Section 379 IPC at Police Station City Samana, Patiala.

FIR was lodged on the complaint of one Nirmal Singh who stated that petitioner alongwith co accused Ravinder Singh entered into premises of Suraj Rice Mills. They picked up 2 paddy bags and threw them outside the wall of the sheller. Before they could be apprehended, they ran away on their scooter. The co accused Ravinder Singh has already been arrested. 1 of the stolen bags of paddy has been recovered from him. As per his disclosure statement, the other paddy bag is with the petitioner.

It is stated that the petitioner is involved in 5 other cases for offences under Sections 379, 380 IPC.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner.

Dismissed.
