The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the complaint No.1687 dated 16.08.2018 submitted by respondent No.5 to the Chairman, Punjab State Commission for NRIs (Annexure P-10), and also for quashing of the FIR No. 16 dated 12.11.2018 registered under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Women, Ferozepur (Annexure P-20).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has handed over a copy of order dated 18.02.2021 passed in CRM-M-29485 of 2020 titled as “*Davis Gill and another versus State of Punjab and others*” as per which the aforesaid FIR has already been quashed

on the strength of compromise executed amongst the parties.

The aforesaid position of fact is affirmed by the Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and he contends that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
