Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No .03 dated 17.1.2020 under section 498A IPC at Police Station Ghuman District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on account of a marital discord between the parties, FIR in question was registered against the petitioner. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 1.11.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No. 2 on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined the investigation. She, on further instructions states that the petitioner is not required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No. 2 has however opposed the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner by
