Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the representations, which have been attached with the present petition, were filed by him in the year 2018 and certain facts, which are necessary to be considered by the respondent-Department, came into existence after the said year, therefore, the petitioner intends to file a detailed representation with the respondents claiming the benefits which the petitioner thinks he is entitled for, keeping in view the services rendered by him with the Department concerned.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner claiming any benefits, the same will be considered in accordance with the facts and circumstances of this case, coupled with the settled principle of law and an appropriate order will be passed on the same within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt

of copy of the said representation and in case the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be released in his favour within a period of next four weeks of passing of the said order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives at this stage, and therefore, he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with the liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
