The present writ petition has been filed with a prayer that the respondent No.3 be directed to frame the time table so that, the petitioner is able to operate his bus on the permit allotted to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite various representations and legal notices issued to the respondents, no action has been taken and rather, the petitioner is being restrained from operating his bus despite having a valid permit.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sh.P.S.Dhillon, Secretary RTA, Ferozepur, submits that though, framing of final time table is
