The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the complaint dated 25.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner, which has already been inquired into, be decided in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that respondent No.7 was re-appointed after his retirement ignoring the claim of the petitioner and the appointment of respondent No.7 was contrary to the rules, which fact was brought to the notice of the authorities by filing a complaint and the complaint is being looked into by the respondents but the said exercise has not been completed for the reasons best known to the respondents even though a period of more than four months has already elapsed, hence the respondents may be directed to conclude the said process in a time bound

manner so as to pass the final order on the complaint of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the complaint dated 25.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) has already been looked into and appropriate orders will be passed on the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel that the complaint filed by the petitioner is being looked into and the grievance raised in the same will be finalized within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, no further grievance of the petitioner in the present petition survives and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

It is made clear that while passing the order on the complaint of the petitioner, all the persons, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the same, be heard and proper procedure for the same be followed.

Ordered accordingly.
