The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 135 dated 04.08.2021, registered under Sections 302, 307, 148, 149, 212, 216, 120-B of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Majitha Road, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that main accused, namely Jaggu Bhagwanpuria, Mani Raiya and Jagroshan Hundal, were having enmity with the complainant and they have attacked the son of the complainant, namely Ranveer Singh @ Rana, who later on died and two other persons also received injuries.

Learned counsel further submits that after the arrest of co-accused Nanit Sharma, the name of the petitioner surfaced along with four other accused, namely Jagtar, Prabhjot Chadda, Laddi Dhariwala and Mandeep Singh @ Toofan that they have helped the accused persons/injured in taking them to the hospital in their car.

Learned counsel further submits that there is no direct

allegation against the petitioner of participating in the crime and even aforesaid four persons have not been chargesheeted by the police.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without making any comment on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the primary allegations against the petitioner would fall under Sections 212 and 216 of the IPC, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted the concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing him a written notice in this regard.
