AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. These three petitions are filed for quashing of challan in FIR No. 222, dated 15th June, 2017, under Sections 323, 324, 447, 506 and 511 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station KUK, District Kurukshetra.

2. As per the pleadings there was a cross version of the incident for which the FIR was registered. These petitions are pending since 2018

and 2019.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that out of twelve prosecution witness, eight witnesses have been examined.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners at this stage restrict their prayer to the extent that the trial be concluded expeditiously.

5. The petitions are disposed of as not pressed.

6. There is no doubt considering that the FIR is of the year 2017, the trial Court with the co-operation of the parties would make an earnest effort to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible, preferably within one year.
