This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.15 dated 11.02.2022, registered for offences under Sections 354, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Women Police Station, Palwal, District Palwal.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation pursuant to order dated 23.03.2022 passed by this Court.

This fact has been verified by the State counsel upon instructions received from L/SI, Vaneet. She further submits that the petitioner has cooperated with the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the FIR, present petition is allowed.

Order dated 23.03.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
