Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, grievance of the petitioner is that the emoluments which have been fixed by the respondents to be paid to her as family pension are not correct and she is being paid less family pension than she is entitled for. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said grievance has already been raised by the petitioner before the competent Authority in the form of a legal notice dated 02.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) but the same is still pending consideration with the Authority concerned which is causing prejudice to her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice dated 02.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab, keeping in view the

advance service of copy of the petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and raises no objection, in case prayer made hereinbefore on behalf of the petitioner for deciding the legal notice dated 02.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner is accepted.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the present case as well as the said legal notice dated 02.02.2022, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 02.02.2022 (Annexure P-6), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled for the relief, the same be also released in her favour within a period of next four weeks of passing of the said order on her legal notice dated 02.02.2022 (Annexure P-6).
