Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that representations have been made for increase of the intake of students prior to coming into force of the new policy and the same have not been decided till date. Reduction in the intake capacity by the Indian National Council was illegal *per se* and thus, the petitioner is entitled to admit the number of students as mentioned in the order of issuance of no objection. He relies upon order dated 09.03.2022 passed in CWP-4546-2022 titled as D.C. Jain College of Nursing Vs. State of Haryana and others.
