[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/1 dated 25.04.2019 in CWP No.10700 of 2019 in case titled as Nachhattar Kaur vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of the order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.10700 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide representation dated 01.01.2019 filed by the petitioner by passing appropriate speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any monetary benefit, to release the same to her within next three months.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondents have accepted the claim of the petitioner vide speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 31.07.2020 (endorsed on 03.08.2020) which is already on record and also released financial benefits to her as per the entitlement determined therein, therefore in the circumstances, he does not

press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 31.07.2020 (endorsed on 03.08.2000)to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] The same is not objected to by the learned AAG.

[5] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.

[6] Rule discharged.
