MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

Since common question of law and facts are involved in these four appeals mentioned hereinabove, they are being taken up together for disposal by way of this common order.

Learned counsel for the appellants, at the outset submits that he would just restrict his submissions to the refund of the bidding amount in the sum of ₹ 6,39,000/- which was paid to the respondent/Board.

This Court would refrain from passing any direction to the respondent/defendant to refund the bidding amount, however, the plaintiff/appellants are at liberty to avail of alternative relief as may be available to them under the provisions of law.

No other point argued before this Court. Accordingly, all the four appeals stand dismissed.
