The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 40 dated 17.05.2021 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Zira, district Ferozepur.

On 06.04.2022, this Court had passed the following order : -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that the petitioner and the injured-complainant, who is his uncle and lives in the same premises as the petitioner, have compromised the matter.

Learned counsel for the complainant acknowledges the aforesaid fact.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gunkirat Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 18.05.2022.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency

as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.40, dated 17.05.2021, registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

After considering the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner in the afore-quoted order and the statement made on behalf of the State, the interim order of this Court dated 06.04.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
