The petitioners herein have approached this Court with a limited prayer that legal notice served upon the respondents and the follow up communications have not been decided. It is submitted that the petitioners herein who are brothers both applied under the advertisement to fill up posts of Male Constables in the District Police Cadre and the Armed Police Cadre. They were selected in both the cadres and the merit list is available on the record. Thereafter before their interviews were conducted, affidavits were taken from the petitioners regarding the option to their joining in the District Police Cadre or Armed Police Cadre. Options were given by the petitioners herein, however, as on date, option exercised by them has not been taken to its logical conclusion.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners herein would submit that despite having exercised their options to join, their option has not

been given to them. Reminders have been sent in this regard. In fact there is a communication received that the case is pending consideration in the office of DGP which should be decided with a reasonable time frame.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. C.L. Pawar, Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and would submit that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the legal notice of the petitioners.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take a decision on the legal notice dated 18.03.2021 (Annexure P-12) and subsequent representations of the petitioners, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
