The passport re-issued to the petitioner with corrected date of birth was impounded when the passport authorities realized that the date of birth mentioned in the application was different from that mentioned in the earlier passport. Thus, the petitioner has approached this Court by way of the present writ petition.

A perusal of the paper book shows that the petitioner had earlier approached the civil Court for correction of his date of birth, but the suit was dismissed. Appeal has also been rejected.

In view of the judgment of the civil Court, which has become final, the petitioner cannot be granted any relief.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
