SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8 and further to inquire the case bearing FIR No.406 dated 07.11.2021, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 IPC at P.C.Pehowa, Kurukshetra through any senior police official at least from the rank of DSP deputed outside the District of Kurukshetra in the light of representations dated 20.12.2021 and 07.02.2022 (Annexures P-6 and P-7 respectively) and to take appropriate legal action against the said private respondents.

It is submitted that various civil cases are going on between the petitioner and respondents No.4 to 8. The said respondents are pressurizing and threatening the petitioner to compromise the matter and withdraw the aforesaid FIR. On 07.11.2021, respondents No.4 to 8 along with their henchmen trespassed the house of the petitioner and gave beatings to the petitioner and his family members. The said incident has also been recorded in the CCTV camera installed outside the house of the petitioner and the said footage is annexed as Annexure P-5. In spite of having all proofs, none of the

police officials was ready and willing to take any legal action against the said respondents, rather Section 452 IPC has intentionally been deleted to make the offence bailable in order to facilitate the accused persons. Consequently, the petitioner moved representations dated 20.12.2021 and 07.02.2022 (Annexures P-6 and P-7 respectively), but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioner is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representations of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amreek Singh Narwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representations of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra to decide the representations dated 20.12.2021 and 07.02.2022 (Annexures P-6 and P-7 respectively) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
