1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 16.09.2021, in CWP-18448-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 16.09.2021, reveals that CWP-18448-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider legal notice dated 17.09.2019 as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if there was no impediment for the release of payment, the same be released to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

3. Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 02.06.2022 passed by the Special Chief Secretary to Govt. of Punjab, Department of Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and Dairy Development Punjab rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in

representation dated 17.09.2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 02.06.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
