Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.26 dated 2.2.2022 registered under Sections 379, 482 IPC at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 22.3.2022 passed by this Court.

Short Reply filed by way of affidavit of SI Navjot Singh, Investigating Officer filed on behalf of respondent-State is ordered to taken on record. State counsel on instructions from SI Navjot Singh has not refuted the assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that recoveries have already been effected and the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation.

As per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner and co-accused

were involved in sale and purchase of stolen cars. Recoveries have already

been effected in the present case and the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 22.3.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
