After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner confines his argument to the extent that he will be satisfied, if trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and decide the same within a stipulated period of time.

It has been informed by learned State counsel that in the present case, 21 witnesses have already been examined out of 22 prosecution witnesses and the matter is fixed for 19.12.2022, before the trial Court.

Since, the FIR was registered way back on 29.05.2019 and the challan was presented on 06.09.2019, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial and decide the same preferably within a period of three months.
