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**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)**

The petitioner has challenged the advertisement issued by the respondents on 21.02.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have obtained one year ITI certification in Mechanical. They should thus be eligible for the post of Tube-well Operator.

Learned counsel for the respondents while referring to the reply submit that the essential qualification is 02 years ITI certificate in Electrical Trade. He also submits that the selection in terms of the impugned advertisement has already been made.

Heard.

The petitioners have done one year ITI certification in Mechanical and are seeking consideration for the post of Tube-well Operator. The respondents in their own wisdom have stipulated two years ITI with Electrical as the essential qualification. In the reply filed by the respondents at para 5, the

relevant competency based curriculum for the Electrical Trade as well as Pump Operator-cum-Mechanical Trade has been elaborately set out.

In view of the above, especially when it is in the domain of the employer to set out the relevant qualification, I do not find any good ground to interfere therewith. Moreover, the selections have already been made.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
