HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that she should be re-adjusted as an Extension Lecturer in Computer Science, on which post, the petitioner had already worked for a period of approximately four years from the year 2013 till the year 2017 but her services were dispensed with on the ground that she did not fulfil the eligibility qualification required for appointment to the post of Lecturer in the said subject.

The prayer of the petitioner is that keeping in view the re-adjustment policy issued by the Government of Haryana dated 04.03.2020, the petitioner is qualified to be treated as displaced Extension Lecturer so as to be re-adjusted but the respondents are not granting the said benefit to the

petitioner.

On the last date of hearing, learned State counsel was requested to inform as to why, the petitioner is not being re-adjusted.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions to submit before this Court that instructions dated 04.03.2020 has been further amended on 11.05.2022 and in case, the petitioner intends for re-adjustment, she should apply afresh in pursuance to the said instructions, which representation, if filed, will be considered in accordance with law and the concerned policy and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents raising the said grievance and if any such grievance is raised by the petitioner, the same be considered in accordance with law as well as the instructions concerned and appropriate order be passed within a period of eight weeks and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same be also extended to the petitioner within a period of next four weeks.
