The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 783 dated 14.12.2021 registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Azad Nagar, Hisar.

On 17.03.2022, this Court had passed the following order : -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case on account of a matrimonial discord between the petitioner and the complainant; the petitioner has no other criminal antecedents; there is no medical evidence to either support the allegations of beating or miscarriage showing falsity in the same and that the petitioner is also ready and willing to join and cooperate with the investigation as and when called by the investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Sheenu Sura, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 18.08.2022.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.783, dated 14.12.2021, registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Azad Nagar, District Hisar, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer."

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation which is now complete and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

After considering the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner in the afore-quoted order and the statement made on behalf of the State, the interim order of this Court dated 17.03.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
