ASHOK KUMAR VERMA, J.

Vide order dated 4.3.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was given another period of 10 days to deposit the amount in compliance with the order dated 13.12.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Appellate Court and the matter was adjourned to 16.3.2020. Operation of the impugned order dated 13.2.2020 was ordered to remain stayed till the next date of hearing. On 16.3.2020, counsel for the petitioner stated that the amount in question was deposited in compliance with the order dated 4.3.2020 passed by this Court. He further submitted that the copy of the order reflecting the deposit of the amount has not been made available and prayed for a week's time to place the same on the record. The matter was thus adjourned to 31.3.2020 and the interim order was directed to continue till next date of hearing. The aforesaid order dated 16.3.2020 was not complied with by the petitioner. On 17.5.2022, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

On 3.8.2022, proxy counsel appeared on behalf of the counsel for the petitioner and on her request, the matter was adjourned to 16.8.2022. Again on 16.8.2022, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Today also none is present on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the matter.

In this view of the matter, the interim order of stay dated 4.3.2020 passed by this Court shall stand vacated and the revision petition is dismissed in default of appearance and for non-prosecution.
