This is a criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of suitable writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondents to release the petitioner forthwith as he has already undergone the imprisonment awarded to him.

Notice of motion was issued in this case and in pursuance of the same, learned State counsel has produced on record a letter dated 23.05.2022 as per which three Pakistani prisoners have been repatriated to Pakistan through ICP Attari Road Amritsar, Punjab. The Pakistani prisoner at serial no.3 is Adnan Ali who is the present petitioner. The said letter dated 23.05.2022 is taken on record as Mark A. The relevant portion of the said letter is reproduced hereinbelow:

“MEMORANDUM

SUB: REPATRIATION OF PAKISTANI PRISONER

Today (23/05/2022), following Pakistani Prisoners were repatriated to Pakistan through ICP Attari Road Amritsar Punjab.

The details of the aforesaid Pakistani Nationals are as under:-

The said Pakistani Prisoners was brought to ICP Attari Road under the Police Escort from Central Jail, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said fact.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

In case any cause survives to the petitioner, it will be open to the petitioner to file a fresh petition.
