1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 04.08.2020, in CWP-11170-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, dated 04.08.2021, reveals that CWP-11170-2020, was disposed of by directing the respondents to look into and decide representations dated 11.03.2020 and 15.07.2020, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

3. Learned AAG, Haryana, refers to order Annexure R/6 dated 25.11.2021, passed by the Director General Education, Haryana, i.e. respondent No.2, deciding the representation submitted by the petitioner, partly accepting the claim made in the representation. Copy of the reply along with Annexure R/6 is stated to have already been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner. However, despite the case having been called out twice, none is present on behalf of the petitioner.

representations dated 11.03.2020 and 15.07.2020 in compliance with order Annexure P-1, dated 04.08.2020, in CWP-11170-2020, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondents. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R?6, to the extent the same denies the relief claimed.
