Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.196 dated 13.12.2019 under Sections 379/411 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the petitioner, who was on regular bail, absented from trial proceedings, whereupon his bail was cancelled by the trial Court vide order dated 14.12.2021.

When confronted with the maintainability of the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., in view of the decision dated 04.04.2019 delivered by this Court in *CRM-M No.15464 of 2019 (Balwant Singh @ Banta Versus State of Punjab)*, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this petition in order to avail alternative remedy in accordance with law.

The prayer is allowed.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
