Main case

Learned counsel for the State submits that statement of the child was recorded and as per which she is living happily in the charitable trust where she is currently staying. In the statement it was also recorded that she does not want to go with her father (present petitioner).

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail all other legal remedies.

It is clarified that father of the child is permitted to meet her without causing any trauma and even paternal/maternal grand parents are also permitted to meet the child and interact with her. In case, the child

refuses to meet, the concerned incharge of the center shall not insist upon

such meeting.

Given above, petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid. It is clarified that filing and withdrawal of the present petition shall not come in the way of filing the fresh petition.
