SANT PARKASH, J.

By this petition, petitioners seek protection to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9, as they are living in live-in relationship against the wishes of said respondents.

In compliance of the order dated 16.03.2021, status report by way of affidavit dated 23.04.2021 of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Crime against Women, Gurdaspur, has been filed and the same is taken on record.

In the above-said status report, it has been mentioned that the statements of the petitioners as well as private respondents No.4 to 8 were recorded. The petitioners in their statements stated that they do not require any protection, while private respondents stated that there is no threat to the petitioners at their hands. The said statements have been annexed with the status report.

Learned counsel for the private respondents does not dispute the above-said factual position.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the stand taken by the private respondents, the present petition may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, it is made clear that the petitioners shall be at liberty to approach this Court if they apprehend any danger to their life and liberty.
