Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.38 dated 24.04.2020, under Sections 342, 365, 376 (DA), 506, 34 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Women Jind, District Jind.

By virtue of order dated 17.03.2022, the petitioners were directed to be released on interim bail on their appearance before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that in compliance of the above said order the petitioners have been admitted to interim bail by the trial Court and they are continuously appearing before the trial Court, so the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same.

In view of the above, the order dated 17.03.2022 is made absolute. The petitioners will keep on continuously appearing before the trial Court during the trial and comply with the directions given by it .

The petition stands allowed.
