The petitioners herein have sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.3 dated 07.01.2021 registered at Police Station Satnali, District Mahendergarh, under Sections 148, 149, 323 & 506 IPC wherein the offences under Sections 325 and 307 IPC are stated to have been added later-on.

Today, on the instructions from ASI Surrender from the above-said Police Station, learned State counsel apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 16.03.2021, as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioners have joined in the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required and they are also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature and moreover, the Challan has already been presented in the Court.

In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel and also the fact that as mentioned in para No.12 of the

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status-report filed on behalf of the respondent-State, by way of the affidavit of Assistant Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh, the petitioners had allegedly caused injuries to the female members of the opposite party by giving them fist and kick blows, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioners named Krishna Devi and Urmila, by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 16.03.2021, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
