The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide the copy of award dated 23.08.2021 stated to have been passed by the respondent authorities and a further prayer to direct the respondents to decide representation dated 13.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner.

Pursuant to the notice issued by this Court, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State informs that the award has not yet been passed and as such, in the absence of the same having been

passed/signed by the competent person, a copy thereof cannot be furnished.

In view of above, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 13.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) in this regard to the respondent authorities requesting them to take expeditious decision on account of an inordinate delay in providing the award. He contends that he would be satisfied in case the respondent authorities are directed to look into the representation dated 13.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) and respond to the same and/or redress the grievances espoused therein.

Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent authorities has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No.1 to consider the representation dated 13.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) relating to the inordinate delay and provide copy of the award by the facilitation council and to pass a reasoned and speaking order within a period of 3 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. Expeditious steps be taken as required to redress the grievance espoused by the petitioner.
