1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/4 dated 23.04.2021, in CWP-8771-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/4 dated 23.04.2021, reveals that CWP-8771-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider legal notice dated 16.12.2020, as representation and decide the same, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Reply has been filed by the learned Addl. AG, Punjab, on behalf of respondent No.2 along with speaking orders Annexure R/1 to R/4. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of the same, states that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order Annexure R/1 to R/4 to claim the other benefits as per entitlement, in accordance

4. The same is not opposed to by the learned Addl. AG, Punjab.
5. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
