The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for proper investigation of case FIR No.140 dated 28.10.2018 under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station Tibba, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana alleging that respondent No.3 has not investigated the matter in a fair and transparent manner. It is also prayed that respondent No.3 be directed to present the challan within the stipulated time.

Today, learned State counsel has stated that challan was filed on 7.11.2019 and charges stand framed vide order dated 3.12.2021 and in the light of the said position, the instant petition does not survive as grievance as raised in the instant petition stands addressed.
