The instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents as they have performed marriage against their wishes.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has failed to make out any case of threat to the newly wedded couple i.e. petitioners. A perusal of file reveals that the representation (Annexure P-4) has been moved by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali regarding threat perception on the same day when they have solemnized the marriage i.e. 11th March, 2022. There is no overt act mentioned on the part of the parents of the petitioners in the afore-said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has also failed to make out a case with regard to threat perception after 11th March, 2022.

At this stage, no case, for providing any protection to the petitioners, is made out.

In view of the afore-said facts and circumstances, the present petition stands dismissed.
