Main case

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of
the Constitution, *inter alia*, for quashing the impugned charge-sheets
dated 06.01.2016 & 18.01.2016 (P-1 & P-2, respectively).

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Learned counsel, while making reference to communication dated 25.05.2022 (P-15), submits that inquiry report, *prima facie*, is in favour of the petitioner; thus, writ petition be disposed off at this stage with a direction to conclude the proceedings on some early date.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed off with the observation that final decision in pursuance of the impugned charge-sheets be taken on or before 28.02.2023, in accordance with law.

Needless to that that in case, decision goes against the petitioner, he would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available, as per law.
