The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 for further investigation of FIR No.358 dated 06.8.2021 under Sections 323/341/506/34 IPC 1860 (P-1) registered at Police Station Tohana without bias and in fair manner as the respondent No.5 (Bhupender Singh @ Kaptan s/o Pola Ram) has been wrongly and illegally exonerated from the above mentioned FIR.

Learned counsel submits that petitioner also filed representation dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending before the authority.

Notices served upon the official respondent(s) through the State's counsel- Mr. Rajat Gautam-DAG, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case directions may be issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad to decide the representation dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) within time bound manner.

The prayer is not opposed.

Given above, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad to decide the representation dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order within 10 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

The petition is allowed to the extent mentioned above. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
